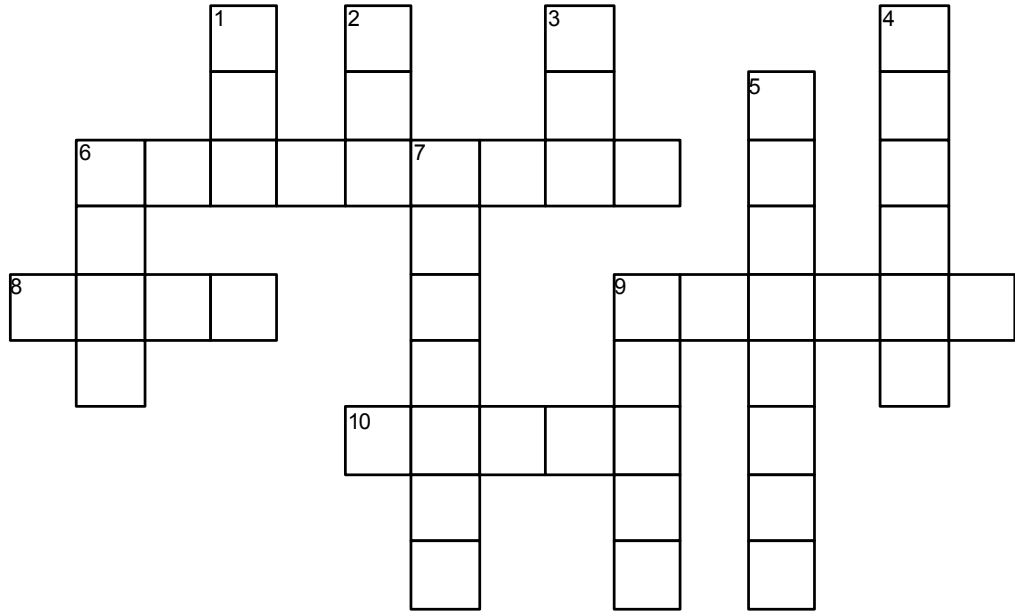


A Tree is a Home ...

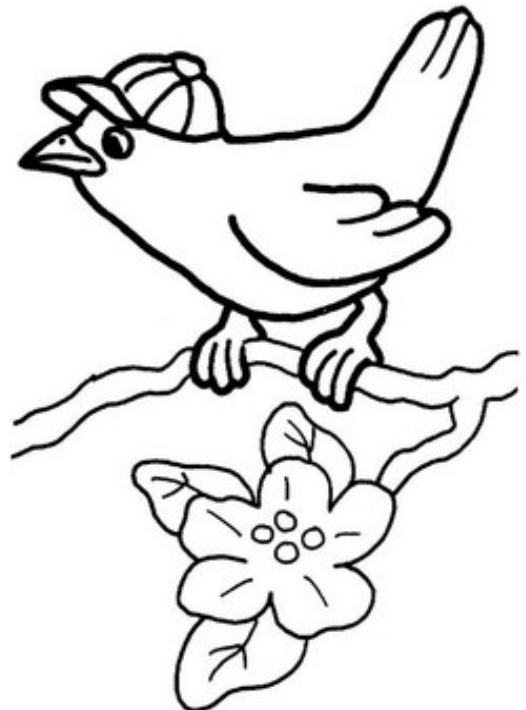


ACROSS
